




Morning announcements start promptly at 7:55 am. Please have your students at school by that time so they can hear all the important information for the day!



After School Care (ASC)

***Please sign out your child everyday with time and signature.**

Only PreK students and their siblings can attend ASC. Just a reminder that **ASC charges are always a day behind.** If your student attended ASC on Wednesday, it will be charged on Thursday. Also, sometimes there will be more charges for one day if Mrs. Obert was unable to enter the charges on a particular day. She always keeps the sign out sheets and records the day each charge is entered. Please call her if you have any questions.
